COMMISSION HOSTS PUBLIC FORUM ON LOBBYING AND CORRUPTION RISKS

8 May 2024

The Commission is examining the integrity risks associated with lobbying and influencing activity in South Australian public administration. Along with this we are considering the adequacy of the current regulatory scheme created by the Lobbyists Act 2015 (SA).

As part of this project the Commission is holding a public forum on Thursday, 9 May 2024 from 10am – 12 noon. The event will be live-streamed, with opportunities for attendees to ask questions of the panel.

The forum will be a panel discussion facilitated by Jodeen Carney, Commissioner of Equal Opportunity SA. The expert panel will be comprised of:
