

The Whistleblower Project Team undertook the following measures to try to ensure that those interested in making a submission would be able to do so:

- the Discussion Paper was published on ICAC’s website, together with a call for submissions, from 29 September 2025 throughout the six-week consultation period
- a media release linking to the Discussion Paper and calling for submissions was circulated to media and published on ICAC’s website from 29 September 2025 throughout the six-week consultation period
- an article was published in The Advertiser on 29 September 2025 referring to the Discussion Paper and the call for submissions
- ABC Adelaide radio reported on 29 September 2025 that the Discussion Paper had been released and a call had been made for submissions
- posts linking to the Discussion Paper and calling for submissions, were published by ICAC on social media platforms X and LinkedIn
- an article calling for submissions and outlining how those interested in the project could have their say was published in the public sector employee newsletter We Are SA on 14 October 2025
- correspondence linking to the Discussion Paper and calling for submissions was sent to a range of individuals and organisations it was anticipated might have an interest in the project, including (for example) responsible officers who had attended ICAC training in the past and Chief Executives of State Government Departments
- the Discussion Paper provided for submissions to be made both by email and by post
- an overview of the legislative framework was included in the Discussion Paper
- extensions of time were granted where sought.
